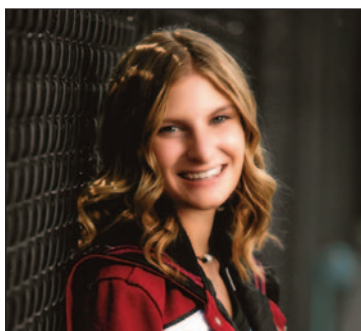

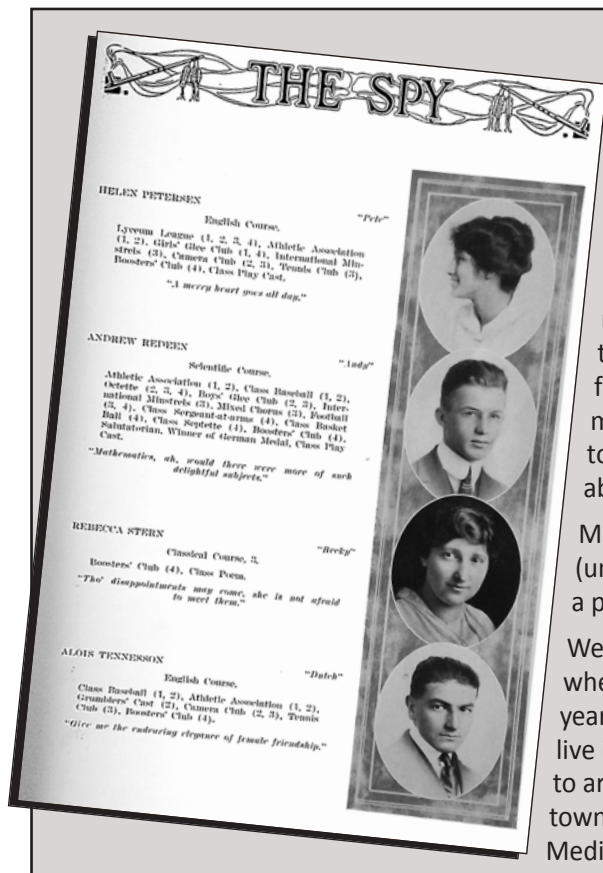
Spy Story

KBHSAA recently received a request from Jan Russ in Washington state, requesting assistance in locating a photo in our Spy yearbook archives. The person of interest was Rebecca Stern, a member of the Bradford Class of 1916. Rebecca passed away when her son was a toddler, and he'd never seen a photo of her.

As you can well imagine, the 1916 Spy is rather fragile. We turned those pages very carefully, and we came across Ms. Stern's senior class photo amongst the section of mid-year graduates. She was noted to have been a member of the Booster Club and to have had a hand in writing the class poem. We used a cell phone to shoot photos from the 1916 Spy: the book's cover, the charming illustration at the start of the mid-year graduates' section, Ms. Stern's senior class photo and the page dedicated to the Booster Club. We emailed them to Ms. Russ, who reports her relative was absolutely thrilled to receive those photos.

Ms. Russ left us with another request, hoping we may eventually find a 1910 Spy (unfortunately, a yearbook we do not have in our archive) and be able to send her a photo of her grandmother.

CLASS REUNION HIGHLIGHTS



Class of 1940 – 80th Reunion Recap

On Saturday, September 19, Marie Goff (nee Pfeiffer) and Charles Heide, members of the Kenosha High School Class of 1940, reminisced for nearly an hour about their years at their alma mater. We moved the location for the classmates' socially distanced gathering to the west side of the building near the school's Gymnasium... we all enjoyed the beautiful sunny day and, in the distance, we could hear a peaceful

BLM protest going on in Civic Center Park. Both Marie and Charles were accompanied by their daughters and a caregiver. Unfortunately, classmates Nell Bosman and Emil Tenuta were unable to attend the event. Charles and Marie chuckled as they compared notes on whether they'd yet reached age 98. They also talked about living through the Great Depression and how, in their respective families, the kids were expected to help out.

Charles notes he was "deprived of my third-grade education because in the early '30s, my family moved out to Somers from Kenosha, where I had been enrolled at Durkee School. My new school was Pike River: one room, eight grades, but since there were no other students in the third grade, I was advanced to fourth. For junior high, I went to McKinley, riding in with my father who needed to be at Nash Motors at 7AM. I recall that in the winter, there was a certain back door, unlocked, that I was able to get in and down into the boiler room, warming up a bit until class started. At Kenosha High School, Miss Doherty impressed us all by exploding hydrogen gas that she made in a test tube containing hydrochloric acid, I guess, and some

metal." Chemistry and English were his favorite subjects.

Marie fondly recalls her Shorthand and German teachers, going to football games and riding her bicycle to school each morning... wearing a dress... because girls of that era did not wear pants. On lunch hour, she would bicycle from Kenosha High School (the current Harborside Academy) back to her home near what is now Washington Middle School, very often accompanied by her good friend, Viola Adelsen. Marie's mother would have lunch waiting for them – usually soup and a sandwich – and then they'd ride back to school to finish out the day.

For more than a dozen years, Doris Magwitz (nee Kirchner) organized twice yearly reunion luncheons for their 1940 Class, before passing in 2018. Marie and Charles miss her and the other classmates who've passed away in the last couple years. They are looking forward to next year's luncheon at the Kenosha Country Club in May and hope the classmates who could not be with them today will be able to attend... and that COVID-19, masks and social distancing will be put behind them.

Nominees are persons who have made significant contributions and who serve or served as a positive role model. Major areas of contribution considered for the award are the following: art, business, criminology, education, entertainment, environment, government, humanities, law, medicine, military, music, science and writing. The field of sports will not be considered, since the Bradford "Hall of Fame" honors outstanding contributions in athletics.

Eligibility Rules

- Open to anyone who attended or graduated from Kenosha Bradford High School, living or deceased.
- Ten years or more since graduation and nominee must have demonstrated significant achievement in a chosen field and/or community service.
- Nominee may have been recognized for involvement in past activities.

Did you know?

In 1891, the first graduating class of what was then Kenosha Central High School (first free high school west of the Alleghenies), founded the Alumni Association with the help of Mary D. Bradford, the teacher for whom the high school was eventually named.

Alumni Association Purpose

3. To recognize and honor distinguished Bradford alumni on their achievements;
4.
