2014 graduating senior applicants are to meet general eligibility requirements for the individual scholarships unless otherwise graph specified. Scholarships will be awarded at the May 2014 Senior Awards Ceremony, and recipients will be invited to the Distinguished Alumni Association Banquet on Saturday, June 21, 2014.

Seniors planning to attend a four year college or university should apply for 2014 KBHSAA Scholarships. Complete a typed alumni scholarship application and submit it, along with one copy of your high school transcript and a copy of ACT and/or SAT score, to Mrs. Robin Mars in room 121 no later than March 21, 2014. College GPA of 2.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale is required unless otherwise specified.




