
# KBHSAA to honor 2017 Distinguished Alumni on June 17th

# CHESTER H. "CHET" WOROCH - CLASS OF 1936

Chet Woroch was a lifelong resident of Kenosha and a proud Bradford graduate. He left Kenosha to serve in the Eighth Army Air Force during World War II. While based in England, he flew 28 missions as a tail gunner on a B-17 bomber. After the war, Chet graduated from UW-Madison with a degree in Construction Engineering.

Upon returning to Kenosha, Chet began a long career in the construction industry, spending over 25 years at Camosy Construction. He supervised construction of many landmark buildings in the city, including St. Catherine's and Kenosha Hospitals, UW-Parkside and Carthage College and many grade schools, libraries, banks and government buildings. His favorite project was a roller coaster and several attractions at Great America.

Chet was active in charitable and church organizations, including the Boy Scouts, St. George Parish Council and St. Vincent de Paul. For many years, he was videographer for St. Joseph's High School football team. At age 62, Chet fulfilled a lifelong dream when he became a private pilot. Ten years later, he returned to





# WILLIAM "BILL" HART - CLASS OF 1947

Bill Hart lettered in Football, Track and Cross Country at Bradford High School, received a gold medal for his 1st place finish in the half mile at State and set an all-time Kenosha High School record, which he held for 12 years.

A lifelong Kenoshan, Bill earned his Associate degree in Data Processing from Gateway Technical Institute. He joined the Kenosha Police Department in April 1956, serving in positions ranging from patrolman walking a beat, motorcycle officer, to Detective, then Lieutenant-Juvenile Bureau, Lieutenant-Records Bureau and Captain-Administration Division. In the mid-1960s, KPD purchased the Automated Law Enforcement System (ALES), and Bill was chosen to oversee its installation. For the first time in KPD history, the Records Bureau easily generated monthly reports on Accidents/Crime and response time statistics for the Chief of Police and City of Kenosha's administration. He is proud to have served under five exemplary Police Chiefs – Stanley Haukedahl, Leo Buchman, Robert Bosman, Dan Cauley and Joseph Trotta – retiring in January 1983.

Bill received a Distinguished Service Award from Kiwanis Club of Kenosha in 1975, a commendation from Mayor John Billotti in 1984 for high caliber ability as both a police officer and administrator and was inducted into the KUSD Sports Hall of Fame in May 2013.



# WILLIAM R. "BILL" SERPE - CLASS OF 1957

Bill Serpe began his business career while still attending Bradford, working at Cohn's Shoe Store in downtown Kenosha. Upon completion of his Bachelor of Business Administration degree at UW-Milwaukee, he joined the U.S. Army Reserves. He moved to New York City, where he met his wife, Barbara Vitale. They married in 1967.

In 1969, Bill joined Colgate Palmolive Company in Global Information Systems. He ultimately became responsible for the Corporate Data Center, Systems Development, Personal Computing and Worldwide Telecommunications, travelling on assignments to Africa, Europe, Canada and Central and South America. He is also a qualified arbitrator for FINRA, an organization authorized by Congress to protect U.S. investors by making sure the securities industry operates fairly.

Since retiring in 1997, Bill has volunteered as a preparer of income taxes for the poor and elderly and has taught personal computing skills to veterans, low income individuals and the recently incarcerated. He and his wife established the William & Barbara Serpe Charitable Trust through which they contribute primarily to educational and medical charities. Whether working or retired, Bill has always pursued his passion for running, and he has completed three New York City Marathons.


