KBHSAA TO HONOR 2019 DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI ON JUNE 22

LOUIS COVELLI - CLASS OF 1973

In 1977, Louis Covelli graduated with honors from UW-Milwaukee with a Bachelor of Science degree in Music. In 1978, he began his teaching career in Sauk Prairie, Wisconsin, as the Director of Bands/Fine Arts Department Head. In 1979, Lou secured a teaching position at Lance Junior High School, and in 1980, he began his tenure at Tremper High School. In 1985, he took a sabbatical and received his Master's Degree in Conducting from UW-Madison, where he received the prestigious Richard C. Church Memorial Conducting Prize. In 1986, he returned to his position as Director of Bands at Tremper. During his Tremper tenure, Lou served as Chair of the Music Department, Director of Bands and Jazz Ensembles, Director of the Tremper Jazz Messengers, founder of the Tremper Chamber Winds and developer/teacher of the AP Music Theory Class, retiring in 2013.

In 2005, Lou was named "High School Teacher of the Year" for Kenosha Unified School District. In 2012, he was named "Advocate of the Year" by the Kenosha Unified PTO Council. For over 25 years, Lou traveled and competed extensively throughout the U.S. and Canada as Director/Advisor of the Band of the Black Watch Summer Marching Band.



Louis and his wife, Susan (Pellegrino), have been married for 34 years, and they have raised two wonderful daughters, Alyssa Colwill, M.D., R.C.M. and Michaela Rickert, P.A., R.D.



In 1891, the first graduating class of what was then Kenosha Central High School (first free high school west of the Alleghenies), founded the Alumni Association with the help of Mary D. Bradford, the teacher for whom the high school was eventually named.
