

Bradford seniors planning to attend a 4-year college/ university are encouraged to apply for the Kenosha Bradford High School Alumni Association (KBHSAA) Scholarships.

Applicants are to meet general eligibility requirements for the individual scholarships unless otherwise specified. College GPA of 2.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale is required unless otherwise specified.

Please download and complete the <u>KBHSAA Scholarship</u>

<u>Application</u>, available on our website, and submit it to Mr. Scott Saling, Bradford Guidance Counselor (Room #216), along with a copy of your high school transcript, no later than Tuesday, April 12, 2022. The application must be typed; handwritten applications will not be considered.

Those seniors selected to receive a KBHSAA Scholarship will be notified before May 25, 2022, hopefully at the Senior Recognition event (or via phone call from Joyce Sorensen, Scholarships Chairperson) with a follow-up confirmation letter to include scholarship details and the criteria to be met. Scholarship recipients for 2022 will be invited to attend the annual Alumni Banquet on Saturday, June 18, 2022 as honored guests of KBHSAA.

For all scholarships awarded, payment is made to the recipient after the 1st semester of college is completed and the specific documentation requirements (criteria and grades) are met. All scholarships are non-renewable (i.e., a one-time award), and payment to the recipient will generally occur on or about January 1, 2023.

### DAA PLAQUE RESTORATION PROJECT

This summer has flown by quickly, aided by the time spent working on the DAA Plaque Restoration Project. On July 16, our small team of volunteers worked with Bradford High School custodians to pack the DAA plaques in protective foam pouches donated by Uline.

Over the years, the afternoon sun streaming through the windows at Bradford's Auditorium entrance had faded – we thought – about a dozen of the DAA honoree photos. As we began to clean the DAA plaques, we found many more photos that were discolored with what our photo retouching expert called "giraffe spots," crackled, delaminating and some, quite literally, were falling apart. We talked to family members throughout the country as we tried to locate replacement photos. We highlight a few efforts below.

- In late June, we visited Jack Andrea, the iconic family-owned shop on 60th Street that would soon close its doors after more than 100 years in business. We chatted with David Andrea, who put us in touch with his cousin, Mary, daughter of Matthew Andrea '36, who promised to send us a replacement photo...success!
- The late Louis K. Brandt '32 served as an Economics Professor at the University of Mississippi, fondly known as "Ole Miss," from 1945-1968. A Google search

indicated his son was an Ole Miss alum and an active supporter of the UM Foundation. We never did find a working phone number for him, so we contacted Anna Langely at UM Foundation, asking if she might pass an email to Mr. Brandt. In less than a week, we had an email from Mr. Brandt's assistant, Debbie, with a photo attached.

• We reached out to the Kenosha History

Center for a photo of Mary D. Bradford. We met with Jon Martens in mid-August to see the photos KHC has in its archives. We selected two very nice photos of Mrs. Bradford for scanning.



• At the suggestion of Joyce Sorensen, we contacted Mary Jane Haugaard-Lippert '47 for assistance in locating a photo of her sister-in-law, Jeanne Lippert '40 (aka Sister M. Collette). "MJ" was instrumental in putting us in touch with Father Paul Lippert '47. We visited him in Menomonee Falls and, after photographing his sister's photo mounted in a beautifully matted arrangement of family photos, we spent a lovely couple of hours reminiscing about his early years in Kenosha. Fr. Paul tells us his sister worked in the Obstetrics Department at the "old" St. Catherine's Hospital and is the

reason so many young mothers who gave birth there named their daughters Collette.





Each DAA honoree's "bio" is mounted using tacks to hold them in place under Plexiglass; we found more than 40 of them had text that was obscured by the tacks... not a good thing when you're planning to photograph the plaques in order to share them on your website. We rekeyed them, had them printed and have remounted them on the plaques. Our photographer has shot close-up photos of 40 of the restored plaques thus far. We are now working to replace 10 of the plaques found to be badly cracked, and we hope to finish up the photography portion of the project before Thanksgiving.

We'll be organizing the DAA plaques in "hanging order" before we return them to Bradford High School to once again be proudly displayed. We've read the bio on each DAA plaque as we worked through this project...we only hope the Bradford students will find the life stories of our DAA honorees as inspiring as we did.

Major areas of contribution considered for the award are the following: art, business, criminology, education, entertainment, environment, government, humanities, law, medicine, military, music, science and writing. The field of sports will not be considered, since the Bradford "Hall of Fame" honors outstanding contributions in athletics.

#### **Eligibility Rules**

- Open to anyone who attended or graduated from Kenosha Bradford High School, living or deceased.
- Ten years or more since graduation and nominee must have demonstrated significant achievement in a chosen field and/or community service.

In 1891, the first graduating class of what was then Kenosha Central High School (first free high school west of the Alleghenies), founded the Alumni Association with the help of Mary D. Bradford, the teacher for whom the high school was eventually named.
