KBHSAA to honor 2021 Distinguished Alumni




JOHN S. GREGORY, CLASS OF 1952

John grew up in the Columbus Park neighborhood, driving and maintaining his father's trucks from the age of 14. Attending classes at Bradford High and Gateway Technical College helped John achieve success in business, engineering and racing. As founder of Sunset Motors and later Mid City U Store, John was active in the Chamber of Commerce, the governor's Highway Safety Committee, The 52nd Street Business Association, the American Motorcycle Association, the NHRA, and Dragbike USA. He was inducted into the Kenosha Legends Hotrod Association and is Legend No. 1 at Great Lakes Dragaway.

John has supported our elected officials in many policy issues that impact the lives of Kenosha residents. As a business leader, he continues to be both business and personal friends with many prominent local, state and U.S. leaders.

HogSlayer, an award-winning true-life story of the dual-engine Norton motorcycle dragster designed, built and raced by John Gregory of Sunset Motors and TC Christenson, was distributed internationally and achieved 5 stars on Amazon Prime. As an engineer, designer and motorcycle industry consultant, John's achievements are recognized worldwide, his motorcycles are in museums in the U.S. and Europe and, at age 87, he still loves riding motorcycles.

John and Carol (Thomas) Gregory raised 7 children before divorcing. John and Jody (O'Connor), his wife of 40 years, enjoy family occasions with 20 grandchildren, 36 greatgrandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren.



MICHAEL H. DEAN, CLASS OF 1960

Michael Dean was the youngest of twins born to Milton C. Dean, Sr., and Shirley (Jacobs) Dean in Kenosha. After graduating from Bradford, he attended UW Extension for two years and spent summers honing his math and people skills while working at his dad's fruit market. He went on to get a bachelor's degree in education and his master's from UW-Whitewater. Mike made Janesville, WI his home, teaching 6th grade at Madison and Monroe Elementary and Franklin Middle School. He married Anna Moss, and they had two children, Steve and Katie.

During his 38-year teaching career, Mike was known for creative and immersive units and was deeply involved in student lives. A former student commented Mike's teaching style was "part Socratic method, part Evangelist, and part Broadway actor." Mike was twice honored as Teacher of the Year in Janesville, where he was instrumental in starting College for Kids. He was also a recipient of the Herbert Kohl Fellowship.

During retirement, Mike volunteered at Kenosha Public Museums and served on its Board. He enjoyed reconnecting with classmates, did yoga twice a week, played men's senior baseball and listened to live music by the lakefront with his fiancée, Wendy. Visits from his children included philosophical discussions with Steve, lakefront walks and making crafts with Katie. He will always be remembered for his beautiful smile, his pride in being a "lefty" and as a lifetime die-hard Cubs fan.

Bradford Alumni Association announces 15 Scholarships offered for 2021

Bradford seniors planning to attend a 4-year college/university are encouraged to apply for the Kenosha Bradford High School Alumni Association (KBHSAA) Scholarships. Applicants are to meet general eligibility requirements for the individual scholarships unless otherwise specified. College GPA of 2.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale is required unless otherwise specified. http://www.kenoshabradfordalumni.com/2021-Scholarships.htm

Please download and complete the <u>KBHSAA Scholarship Application</u> (available on our website) and submit it to Mr. Scott Saling, Bradford Guidance Counselor (Room #216), along with a copy of your high school transcript, no later than Tuesday, April 13, 2021. The application must be typed; handwritten applications will not be considered.

Those seniors selected to receive a KBHSAA Scholarship will be notified before May 30, 2021, hopefully at the Senior Recognition event (or via phone call from Joyce Sorensen, Scholarships Chairperson) with a follow-up confirmation letter to include scholarship details and the criteria to be met. Scholarship recipients for 2020 and 2021 will be invited to attend the annual Alumni Banquet on Saturday, June 26, 2021 as honored guests of KBHSAA, along with the Distinguished Alumni Award recipients for both years (an extradordinary situation brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic).

For all scholarships awarded, payment is made to the recipient after the 1st semester of college is completed and the specific documentation requirements (criteria and grades) are met. All scholarships are non-renewable (i.e., a one-time award), and payment to the

Spy Donation Bonus: Mid Century Momentos


We recently received donations of a 1952 Spy and a 1955 Spy. We'd hate to think of a Spy ending up in a landfill when its owner "no longer needs it." We gratefully accept donations of any Spy yearbook. The 1955 edition has been placed in our library, and the 1952 edition is available for resale. When we sell a Spy, the

proceeds support KBHSAA programs.

Included with that '52 Spy was a charming scrapbook compiled by its owner – we'll call her

Ella (not her real name) – to capture details of her senior year at Bradford High School, September 8, 1951 to June 6, 1952. Individual report cards for each subject Ella took during her senior year were tucked inside the back cover, along with a '52 pin to commemorate her high school graduation – a gift from St. Thomas church. The scrapbook's *Autograph* pages were filled with embossed "calling cards" bearing the names of classmates, most with handwritten personal messages on the back.

Simply illustrated pages provided space for remembering *Favorite Teachers, Clubs and Organizations, Sports,* etc. On a page entitled *Quiz,* we glimpsed Ella's list of favorite songs and singers. We recognized some of those old song titles: "I'm Yours" and "Anytime," recorded by Eddie Fisher; and "Cry," recorded by Johnnie Ray. On a page entitled *Boys in Our Life,* Ella reminisced about her first boyfriend, who left Kenosha on January 23, 1952, bound for Fort Sheridan and a three-year commitment to serve in the U.S. Army.





On the *Class of 1952* page, Ella noted names of the Class Officers (we recognized a couple KBHSAA member names); the Class Flower; and the Class Colors: "King's Blue and Silver." Having graduated from Bradford in the 70s, we don't recall our senior class selecting class colors, do you? The Class Motto is not attributed to anyone in particular: "There are better men to be found than the best." A Google search for that quote yielded just a single entry, a link to the *Kenosha News* Archives for an article published on June 6, 1952.

The Commencement page is annotated as "The Big Day, Friday, June 6, 1952 – 8:00 p.m." Ella wrote that after the ceremonies were over, she "rushed out to find mom and dad, and gee I was I proud of them, proud to know I had such marvelous parents, and proud of myself to be able to show them I had made it. I hope the rest of my life will be happy and successful, and I hope I find the thing I want most. Now my life is my own, and it's up to me to make something of myself." We couldn't help but think: the more things change, the more they stay the same.
