## **Bradford Field House Update**

A \$2.8 million project to completely rebuild and replace the Bradford High School Field House floor was approved by the KUSD School Board at its meeting on March 28, 2023. The decision brought a round of cheers from those in the audience as the School Board authorized 2023-24 projects as part of the district's capital improvements plan.

The project, begun in July, involves removing both layers of flooring, demolishing and removing the concrete sub-floor, installing a new storm water management system, pouring a new concrete sub-floor, installing

a new wood and rubber gym floor and installing new bleachers.

In an email dated 10/03/2023, Principal Brian Geiger reports, "The project is going well. Concrete is done, sound system is going in, painting the ceiling and walls. Then we will look to put in floors, then bleachers. Project is looking to be done before the new year!"

In 1891, the first graduating class of what was then Kenosha Central High School (first free high school west of the Alleghenies), founded the Alumni Association with the help of Mary D. Bradford, the teacher for whom the high school was eventually named.
