# KBHSAA to Honor 2013 Distinguished Alumni on June 22nd

### JOHN W. ANDERSON, SR. - CLASS OF 1957



After high school and the military, John Anderson worked at American Motors to save for his college education at UW-Milwaukee. He completed his education at Ohio State University with a B.S. in Business Administration-Marketing and a Master of Public Administration. In 1979, he was Board certified in health care administration by the American College of Health Care Executives (ACHE).

John served as CEO for four Chicago hospitals – including a 950-bed teaching hospital. He served as a board member and board leader of Fairview Baptist Home during a time when the nursing home was transformed into a Continuing Care Retirement Community on 40 acres, after a \$50 million bond issue was procured. He has taught course work in 15 states for the ACHE, assisting hospital administrators to become board certified and has mentored more than 100 hospital executives over a 20-year period. He is well recognized by the ACHE: Fellow; Life Fellow; elected Regent of ACHE for Northern Illinois; Governor from for Illinois, Indiana, Michigan and Wisconsin; and recipient of the ACHE Senior Health Care Executive Award in 2006.

He has served on missionary construction teams with Mission Impact, building schools in the mountain areas of Guatemala. After singing for years with a group called Singing Men of Oakbrook, John founded an all-male chorus called the Singing Men of South Central Wisconsin. This group sings mostly Gospel music, and its performances are geared to help raise money for worthy causes.

#### **DENNIS M. FILIPPELLI - CLASS OF 1956**



Dennis Filippelli has an MA degree in Education and Psychology from Cardinal Stritch College and completed additional post graduate work at Marquette University, UW-Madison and the University of Alabama. He has dedicated his professional life to working with children and adults with academic, behavioral and developmental disabilities. He has been a teacher, counselor, administrator and psychologist. Currently, he is as an instructor at Carthage College, supervising new teachers.

Dennis was the Executive Director of the Developmental Disabilities Service Center for over 20 years. He served on the Governor's Committee for People with Disabilities and was appointed to the Wisconsin Council on Developmental Disabilities by four different governors over a 25-year period.

He has been an honoree and past President of the Italian Business and Professional Association, the Kenosha County Ice Arena, the Wisconsin Chapter of the American Association of Developmental Disabilities and the Wisconsin Council in Developmental Disabilities. He has received the Kenosha Jaycees Outstanding Young Man

of the Year Award, selected as one of the Outstanding Young Men of America for Community Service.

Dennis has served on the Kenosha Public Museums Board of Trustees and currently serves on KPM's Foundation Board of Directors. He has also served on the Bradford Alumni Association Board of Directors and the Wisconsin and Gateway Associations of School Psychologists.

#### CARMELO D. TENUTA – CLASS OF 1983



Carmelo Tenuta attended pre-med at UW-Parkside and graduated from Northwestern University Medical School with a B.S. in Physical Therapy. After working for a local physical therapy firm he decided to start his own company. Sports Physical Therapy grew from a single outpatient physical therapy center specializing in orthopedic rehabilitation and prevention to 16 sites in southeast Wisconsin and northeast Illinois, with 240 employees. In 2010, Sports Physical Therapy merged with Accelerated Rehab. Carmelo is also owner/founder of Occupro, a web-based software product; LivingWell Home Medical Supplies, a retail outlet selling home medical supplies; and Sports 24 Fitness, a 24-hour fitness center with 450 members.

Carmelo has been published in The Journal of Orthopedic Physical Therapy for a research project involving rehabilitation of high school athletes. He has presented nationally for the Private Practice Section of the American Physical Therapy Association. Carmelo has also been a guest lecturer at The Chicago Medical School, UW-Parkside, Carthage College and Gateway over the years.

Carmelo believes in giving back to the community and to others around him. He has donated countless hours in early years, working with UW-Parkside athletes and provided a major contribution for naming rights of the Carmelo D. Tenuta Hall for Sciences and Sports Medicine at UW-Parkside. In addition, Carmelo supports numerous community and charitable organizations.





In 1891, the first graduating class of what was then Kenosha Central High School (first free high school west of the Alleghenies), founded the Alumni Association with the help of Mary D. Bradford, the teacher for whom the high school was eventually named.
