KBHSAA to honor 2016 Distinguished Alumni on June 25th

JERRY BAIN - CLASS OF 1957



Jerry began his career at Abbott Labs in 1964, retiring in 1998 as a meeting and event director. He then worked in the same capacity for Med Ed-Link as a consultant for eight years. In that role, his late wife Pat worked alongside him, and they traveled the world directing meetings.

Throughout his life, Jerry has been involved in groups that aid others. His involvement began in the Jaycees where he participated for many years, was the local chapter president, a state vice president and on the National Board. When he aged out of Jaycees, Jerry moved on to Kiwanis of Western Kenosha and volunteers for the group's many programs. In 2004, he recognized the need to protect against identity theft and began the Shred Away Hunger program which provides free shredding of materials in exchange for food and other donations. He has also been a part of planning the Taste of Wisconsin event for the past several years and works it every year as well.

Jerry has served on the board of directors for Hospice Alliance, Inc. and for The Goodfellows (Kenosha Christmas Charities), a charitable organization which aids disadvantaged children in Kenosha County. Jerry has three children and five grandchildren and is proud to be a Bradford graduate.

KEITH BOSMAN - CLASS OF 1967

Keith was a member of Bradford's football, basketball and baseball teams. He is a graduate of UW-Parkside. Keith and his wife, Deborah, raised two daughters, Amy and Ann, and have two grandchildren.

Keith worked for over thirty years in foodservice marketing, the last eighteen for Dierks-Waukesha Foodservice as a regional coordinator. Since 1988 he has been involved in City government, serving six terms on the City Council, serving on the Police and Fire Commission and, from 2008 to 2016, as Mayor of Kenosha.

As Mayor, he was instrumental in the planning and economic development which brought many new jobs to Kenosha by attracting businesses such as Amazon's Fulfillment Center, Kenall Manufacturing, Meijer and the 5th Avenue Lofts. He played an integral role in the city's partnership with KAC to develop the Dream Playground, Kenosha's first fully accessible playground; the redevelopment of historic Simmons Field, home of the Kenosha Kingfish; the rebuilding of the Washington Park Velodrome; and many other projects.

He helped develop many lakefront events and festivals such as the Wisconsin Marathon, Celebrate America and Cheesapalooza. He served on the board of directors of the Christian Youth Council as well as the AMB Foundation in memory of his daughter, Amy. Active in Rotary West, he organized and ran the City Softball Tournament from 1980-1992. Keith is a member of the Kenosha Softball Hall of Fame.



PAUL A. CAPELLI, M.D. - CLASS OF 1949




Paul received his undergraduate and medical education from Marquette University with the Class of 1956, recognized with Alpha Omega Alpha Honors. After service in the U.S. Air Force, he and his wife Mary returned to Kenosha in 1962 with their family. Paul was an obstetrics and gynecology physician and surgeon in private practice from 1962-1994. Because of his lifelong passion for children's education, Paul ran for election and served on the Kenosha Unified School District #1 Board of Education from 1968 to 1971.

In 1994, Paul became the first medical director for Aurora Health Care in Kenosha. With his leadership contribution, Aurora built its first Kenosha outpatient clinics, and then followed with the opening of its Kenosha hospital in 1998. In 2003, Paul retired to focus on his volunteer activities in the Kenosha community.

Paul was an active Rotarian for many years, recognized for his service with the Paul Harris Award. Today he is an active member and volunteer with the Kenosha YMCA and the Marquette University Alumni Association.

With the passing of his cherished wife, Mary, after almost 60 years of marriage, Paul proudly reflects on the joyful raising of their six sons and four daughters in Kenosha, and the blessings of their 32 grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

New Bradford Stadium

The long awaited stadium at Bradford High School is extremely close to being a reality. Final preparations are being completed and the first process of this large project began before the end of March! The new stadium will be located on campus along 39th Avenue, just north of the current parking lot. Features in this stadium include a turf field, 9-lane track, seating capacity for 3,000 spectators along with a team/concession/public restroom building.

Adding a stadium at Bradford High School has led to a major reconfiguration to the north end of the campus and this reconfiguration takes advantage of much unused acreage across the street at Bullen Middle School. The new stadium will be located where the tennis courts and girl's softball diamond are located currently and therefore force the move of those facilities across the street. This new arrangement will provide not only new tennis and varsity softball facilities, but will create room for a JV baseball field, JV softball field, and three new multi-purpose fields used for activities such as soccer and football practice.



As the excitement continues to grow for this fantastic project, Bradford administration has campaigned and recruited local businesses to sponsor a video scoreboard at the new stadium. This scoreboard will be the first in the area and one of the best high school video boards in the Midwest! We hope to see you at a game this fall when we open Bradford's new Stadium!



Did vou know?

In 1891, the first graduating class of what was then Kenosha Central High School (first free high school west of the Alleghenies), founded the Alumni Association with the help of Mary D. Bradford, the teacher for whom the high school was eventually named.

Alumni Association Purpose

- 1. To promote Bradford High School and its activities;
- 2. To give and facilitate scholarships to deserving Bradford seniors;
- 3. To recognize and honor distinguished Bradford alumni on their achievements;
- 4. 
